Licenses: Participants must purchase a \$3.00 Nordiq Canada event licence (*not applicable to BV Nordic Rabbit program registrants). The event licence fee will be automatically added to all race registrations on Zone 4 and the revenues sent directly to Nordiq Canada. Other race licenses are not required for this event.

Start List/Draw: Mass start for all categories, self-seeded.

Bib Pick-Up: Race Day, 8:30 am to 10:00 am, at the main lodge race office.

Awards: Award presentations will take place immediately following the race.

Concession: Lunch is included with participant race registration. Registrants can buy extra meal tickets at Zone4.ca when registering.

Waxing: Indoor wax space is available in the Gary Murdoch Memorial Waxing Hut. Space is limited. Outdoor power is available for waxing. Bring your own equipment.

CCBC Rule Regarding the Use of Fluorinated Waxes

Cross Country BC continues to follow the national (Nordiq Canada) and global ski community (FIS) in the strategy to eliminate fluorinated waxes.

Trail pass: Spectators do not require a trail pass to watch the race. If you are not a racer or a coach, you will require a day pass to use the trails on the day of the race.

Refunds/Cancellation: There will be no refund for participants who do not start their race.

If race organizers cancel the race(s) due to unsafe weather conditions, a full refund will be made to participants except for any online processing fees. Races will be cancelled or postponed if temperature or weather conditions are unsuitable at start time.

Per Nordiq Canada regulation 315.9:

“With air temperatures below -20°C (temperature measured at the coldest point of the course and without wind factor) and competition distances less than or equal to 15 km, the Jury must postpone or cancel the competition. For athletes under 12 years of age, with air temperatures below -15C (temperature measured at the coldest part of the course and without a wind factor), the Jury must postpone or cancel the competition.”

Race Routes: Maps will be posted on the event webpage and at the BV Nordic lodge prior to the race.

Awards: Times will be recorded and available on Zone4.ca after the race.
Awards provided to the first 3 participants in each category of 9 km and longer.
Bunnies and Rabbits will receive a prize at the finish line.

Feed Stations: Feed stations will be set up on the course with water, sports drink, and some goodies to keep your energy up. Feed Stations generously provisioned by **McBike and Sport**.

Bunnies/Rabbits: Every Bunny/Rabbit participating in the Loppet must in zone 4. There is no fee charged to Bunny/Rabbit participants.

- Bunnies and Rabbits must be accompanied by an adult on the race-course. These adults do not require event registration but must have trail pass.
- All Bunnies and Rabbits will receive a lunch as a race participant.
- Bunny/Rabbit parents may purchase a lunch on Zone 4.
- A Bunny Parade (led by a Giant Bunny) will happen immediately prior to the mass start. The purpose of the Bunny Parade is to celebrate the participation of Bunnies and Rabbits this season. The parade also ensures they are grouped together and safely seeded at the back of the mass start.
