- 1. Additions /Adoption of agenda
 - Coach training policy
 - Thank you Letter to Russell Klassen

- 3. Correspondence and emails (Kirsteen)
 - Notice from Ministry of Health approving payment of our permit for the kitchen.
- 4. Bookkeeping/Finances (LB)
 - Program and overall club budget reviews and update for year-end finals and next year budget forecast.
 - Motion. Jill O. "Be it moved that the club restrict \$13,000 for 3 years for the purpose of contributing towards the purchase of a club van" All in favour. Motion carried.
- 5. Reports
 - a. Membership (J.K.)
 - Ticket booth sales are down: last year-to March 31st \$5639.59, this year \$5290.29.

 - b. Promotions (L.H.)
 - Nothing new.
 - ACTION: Post an AGM (May 8th) notice in the newspaper and post signs at the sports stores.
 - ACTION: Leanne will get Loretta to send out an email announcing the gate close April 16th.

- c. Lodge/ Area &Community forest (Brant)
 - Nothing new.
 - Gate will be locked April 16th.
- d. Race committee(Steve)
 - Marathon on March 3rd. Rabbits will attend, over 100.
 - Pre-marathon pot-luck and dessert night on Friday night.
- e. ADP: (Liz H)
 - Skiers at Nationals had a great time and good results.
 - Both Gabriel and Kate had top 5th, 10th and 15th finishes
 - Kate had an overall 8th aggregate score and Gabriel had 9th aggregate score.
 - Liz circulated their accounting of their Nationals fundraising and expenses and a request for funds; that being less than the originally thought.
 - Last ADP meeting was very constructive and inclusive of all skill programs..
 - Leslie-Jean has set up the Ford Drive-1 fundraiser. Get as many people as possible out to drive.
 - Grants going in for club and coach funding.
 - Ski Boosters has been very effective in fundraising and keeping parents and kids organized on the lodge tasks.
 - Jill O. mentioned that there was an issue between a couple coaches and the matter was forwarded to the dispute resolution committee. It is under review.
 - Motion Brant moved. " Let it be moved that the BVCCSC will budget for and provide \$10,000 annually toward the paid coach position. Furthermore the board commits to underwrite the balance of funds required, if needed to cover a deficit in the coaching budget provided the ADP understands they are committed to fundraising to acquire those funds." g. Biathlon

- Season has shown the program is integrated in the ADP.

- h. Back country (Dave P.)
 - Starr creek has had \$870 in revenue. Nothing from Harold Price.
 - Snowmobile club has gone in and done some maintenance and bucked some firewood.
 - Dave has encouraged them to do maintenance and offset use with no fee for the cabin use in exchange.
 - Dave would like to schedule a firewood collecting work party some time.
 - RAMP- Dave has requested that if the Starr Creek area gets designated as non-motorized area, that there be a limited motorized access clause in any future agreement to allow access for maintenance of the cabin.

6. Misc Business:
