Visitor: Tenley Dahlie - Discussion on Cansi ski instruction

- Tenley presented what Cansi is and how it differs from NCCP (handout)
- Cansi is not race focussed, as is NCCP. NCCP is skills focussed while Cansi is focussed on how to instruct ski skills
- Cansi 1 course costs about \$150 for a weekend course.
- We have a growing Masters ski program (evenings)- some instructors are asking about getting instruction on how to instruct skiing skills.
- Cansi is not recognized by CCBC for coaches in youth programs. They subscribe to the NCCP system (IC,CC,L2T, etc)
- There is a potential liability issue with teaching ski skills if the instructors aren't certified in some fashion.
- ACTION ITEM: Tenley wil look into the costs of hosting a CANSI Level 1 course and report back to the board those costs and any potential interest there may be for this course.

Visitor discussion: Membership fee structure (Liz Osborn presentation)

- There is an apparent fee imbalance in the current club fee structure with respect to children members. See fee structure analysis paper.
- The current fee structure is based on a person (single) versus multiple (family) with no accounting for age. So a single child member joining rabbits would pay the same club fee as an adult, which seems disproportionate.
- The issue does not impact adult fees, only youth.
- Liz has proposed a new fee structure for next season (see attached document).
- MOTION: Ken Eng
 - Be it proposed that the proposed, revised club membership fee structure be put forward at the next BVCCSC AGM for a membership vote. Carried
- Liz also provided a chart with BVCCSC membership data with skill Dev program numbers, for our info.
- Refund policy discussion: When membership fee refunds are requested after Dec 10th (annually), the CCBC amount will not be refunded nor any processing fees. These fees will have already been paid out by the club and are non-recoverable.

What the Changes Mean

- 1. No change to membership dues + CCBC fees + processing fee for Adults registered as Single or Couple.
- 2. More equitable for Student, Youth & Child. Everyone pays same dues based on age instead of whether kid registers as a Single or part of a Family. For some kids, this is a decrease in dues, for others it's an increase.
- 3. Each member pays their full CCBC fees. BVCCSC no longer subsidizes CCBC fees for families of 5 or more.
- 4. CCBC membership fee is a standalone charge. This allows BVCCSC to respond right away to changes in the CCBC rate. No need for an AGM resolution since CCBC fees aren't part of BVCCSC "annual membership dues". When CCBC raises its fee, BVCCSC passes the full amount directly onto members.

5. Processing Fee for registering by Paper Form increases for families of 3 or more. No change to online processing fee paid to Zone4.
